### Case file analysis

#### Levels of Analysis:

- First level
  - What's there, by whom was it created, and for what purpose?
  - To whom is it directed and with what expectation?
- Second level
  - What does the information tell us?
  - What seems to be missing?
- Third level
  - How is the information acted upon?
  - How are information gaps handled?
  - How does that impact victim safety and offender accountability?

#### First Level Analysis:

- Where in the file do we see information about domestic violence?
  - What information is there?
  - Who generated it?
  - Why was it generated? To establish what?
  - How was it generated? According to what guidance?
  - To whom is the information directed?
  - What is that person expected to do with the information?
- Where in the file *don't* we see information about domestic violence that we would expect to see?
  - Who would be expected to provide that information?
  - What might contribute to the gap? (there's no instruction, nobody asked, not my job)
- What problems does this create for....
  - Battered parents?
  - Children?
  - The system?
- What can be done to address the gaps?
  - Forms
  - Administrative practices
  - Concepts and theories
  - Training
  - Resources
  - Linkages
